Garbage & Recycling

Garbage pickup is early Monday. There are no rules as to when you put your garbage out. Recycling and garbage are picked up separately. You are entitled to 12 bulk and/or electronic pickups per year, but they must be scheduled in advance with John's Disposal at 262-473-4700.

Phone

Cell service is very address specific. The best way to see what works at your new house is to look at the number of bars on your friends' phones when they are over and choose the provider with the highest number of bars. You can also talk to your provider about "boosters." Once you have Internet, consider turning on Internet assisted calls in your phone settings. It might help. Most landline services have disappeared from the area, so I cannot provide recommendations.
